HIGHLIGHTS: ANZAC COVE, LONE PINE CEMETERY, TURKISH WAR MEMORIAL

Meet the guide at the lobby of your hotel

Every morning departs at 06:30 am

Following early departure from your hotel we drive about five hours and arrive to Eceabat where we have lunch. Following lunch we drive to the entrance of the Gelibolu National Park. We will pay visit to Kabatepe War Museum, Beach Cemetery (John Simpson's Grave), ANZAC Cove, Ari Burnu (First ANZAC landing place), Lone Pine Cemetery (Australian memorial), Johnston's Jolly (Walk in the ANZAC trenches), View Shrapnel Valley, Turkish Memorial, The Nek and Walker's Ridge, Chunuk Bair (Main New Zealand memorial). Following the tour we drive back to Istanbul.



2 DAYS 1 NIGHT TROY and GALLIPOLI TOUR (39)

HIGHLIGHTS: TROY, ANZAC COVE, LONE PINE CEMETERY, TURKISH WAR MEMORIAL, GALLIPOLI EPIC SIMULATION CENTER

Meet the guide at the lobby of your hotel

Every morning departs at 06:30 am

Price includes: guiding, transportation, lunch, entrance fees, 1 night 3* hotel accomodation

Day 1: Following early departure from your hotel we drive about five hours and arrive to Eceabat where we have lunch. Following lunch we drive to the entrance of the Gelibolu National Park. We will pay visit to Kabatepe War Museum, Beach Cemetery (John Simpson's Grave), ANZAC Cove, Ari Burnu (First ANZAC landing place), Lone Pine Cemetery (Australian memorial), Johnston's Jolly (Walk in the ANZAC trenches), View Shrapnel Valley, Turkish Memorial, The Nek and Walker's Ridge, Chunuk Bair (Main New Zealand memorial). Following the tour we drive to Eceabat where we stay at our hotel.

Day 2: Following breakfast we depart from hotel. We take the ferryboat to cross the Dardanelles. Following half hour drive we proceed to legendary city of **Troy**, where the Trojan War between Greeks and Trojans took place in 1250 BC which was a very important settlement in the Bronze Age. A replica of Trojan horse can be also seen. To date, nine strata were identified and dated down to up. Later we depart to Canakkale where we have free time to explore this beautiful city by the Dardanelle Strait. We arrive back to our hotel in Istanbul late in the evening.

Ottoman Empire was one of the largest empires in the history. Bursa was its first capital. The city that is settled on the northwestern slopes of Mount Uludağ is known as "Yeşil Bursa" (meaning "Green Bursa") from its beautiful parks and gardens located throughout the city. This fourth largest city of Turkey is also known for its peaches, chestnuts, and silk industry. Your journey begins in the morning at your hotel where you will be picked up. We arrive in Bursa after a three-hour drive. We walk for some time and then have lunch in one of the traditional restaurants in the old town. In the afternoon we continue touring the city until dusk. Many historical monuments are on our list such as Muradiye, Mausoleums of Osman and Orhan Bey, Grand Mosque, Green Mosque, Koza Han, Covered bazaar and many others. We will return the same way as we arrived in Bursa and arrive in Istanbul at your hotel about 8 pm.



HIGHLIGHTS: SELIMIYE MOSQUE, BAYEZID HOSPITAL, HISTORICAL BRIDGES

Edirne is the western most city of Turkey. It was the second capital of Ottoman Empire. Its founder – Hadrian gave its first name: Hadrianople. It is in Edirne where Sinan completed his masterpiece Selimiye Mosque- recently declared as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Ottoman Sultans of 15th century built magnificent mosques, medreses, baths, palaces which still remain. Bayezid 2. Commissioned a large complex that consists of a mosque, hospital building, imaret and medrese. Today award winner Museum of Health expose beautiful statutes made of wax and some artifacts from the Ottoman medical history. Traditional soaps, brooms, cheese are some of souvenirs that you may take back home.



HIGHLIGHTS: Devrent Valley (Imagination Valley), Pasabag (known as monk valley) Lunch at Avanos, Red river (Kızılırmak), Goreme open air museum, Uchisar castle, Rose Valley, Cavusin, Pigeons Valley, Kaymakli Underground City, Ortahisar Natural Rock Castle, Derinkuyu underground city, Ihlara Valley, Melendiz River, Selime cathedral

Every Day

Day 1: Devrent Valley where the geographical formations remind a place of another planet. Then in Pasabagi, you'll take a stroll between the amazing fairy chimneys of Cappadocia. From there, driving to Avanos to have lunch. After having the lunch you leave from Avanos to see the most beautiful examples of Byzantine art in Goreme Open Air Museum. Then you'll drive to Uchisar Castle, the highest point of the region, where you will have a fabulous panoramic view over Cappadocia.

Day 2 : On a 4 km hike through the Rose Valley visiting the churches. Afterwards visit the old Christian village of Cavusin. Stop for lunch in Pigeons Valley and then continue to see the marvel of construction that is the Kaymakli Underground City. You will also visit the Ortahisar Natural Rock Castle.

Day 3: Derinkuyu underground city, deepest underground city of region. After Derinkuyu, you will explore Ihlara valley and melendiz river. Ihlara is famous hiking place of region. After 4 km hiking lunch over Melendiz river. You will taste local foods, cooked by local peoples. Last place is Selime cathedral, wonderful and huge fairy chimney.



DAILY EPHEBUS TOUR – (43)

We will visit Pamukkale Travertines and Hierapolis Ancient City which is the center of natural thermal spring waters with healing properties. Due to the chemical properties in the water, pure white colored travertines and stepped water terraces have been created on the mountain slope. It is for its resemblance to cotton piles that it is called 'Cotton Castle' in Turkish. We stop on the way at a 4 star hotel for lunch and swimming in thermal red waters. Then visit the travertines and the ancient city of Hierapolis which has the biggest necropolis with 1200 gravestones in Anatolia. The sacred pool also is one of the highlights of the site. There shallow thermal waters ripple over a wonderful scattering of ancient Roman ruins that lie beneath.



2 DAYS 1 NIGHT EPHEBUS, PAMUKKALE TOUR – (45)

BY PLANE OR BUS
